**SUBJECT:** ALTERNATIVES FOR REVISED COUNCIL DISTRICT MAPS BASED ON CRITERIA AND DIRECTION ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMITTEE



**BACKGROUND:**

On May 12, 2011, the Committee directed Staff to bring back redistricting scenarios which adhere to the following criteria:

1. Nearly equal population (District population size of 23,001 individuals per the 2010 Census with a 5% deviation or from 21,851 individuals to 24,151 individuals per Council District)
2. Compact
3. Contiguous
4. Major thoroughfares as boundaries
5. Keeping together communities of interest (Respect Identified Neighborhoods)

Also, the Committee directed Staff to bring back the following scenario types which follow the above-mentioned criteria:

1. North-South Scenario (Columnar)
2. East-West Scenario (Layered)
3. Drawn from Center Scenario
4. Existing Boundaries with Expansions Scenario

The scenarios are attached to this memo and are numbered Map #1 thru #10 with the listing as follows:

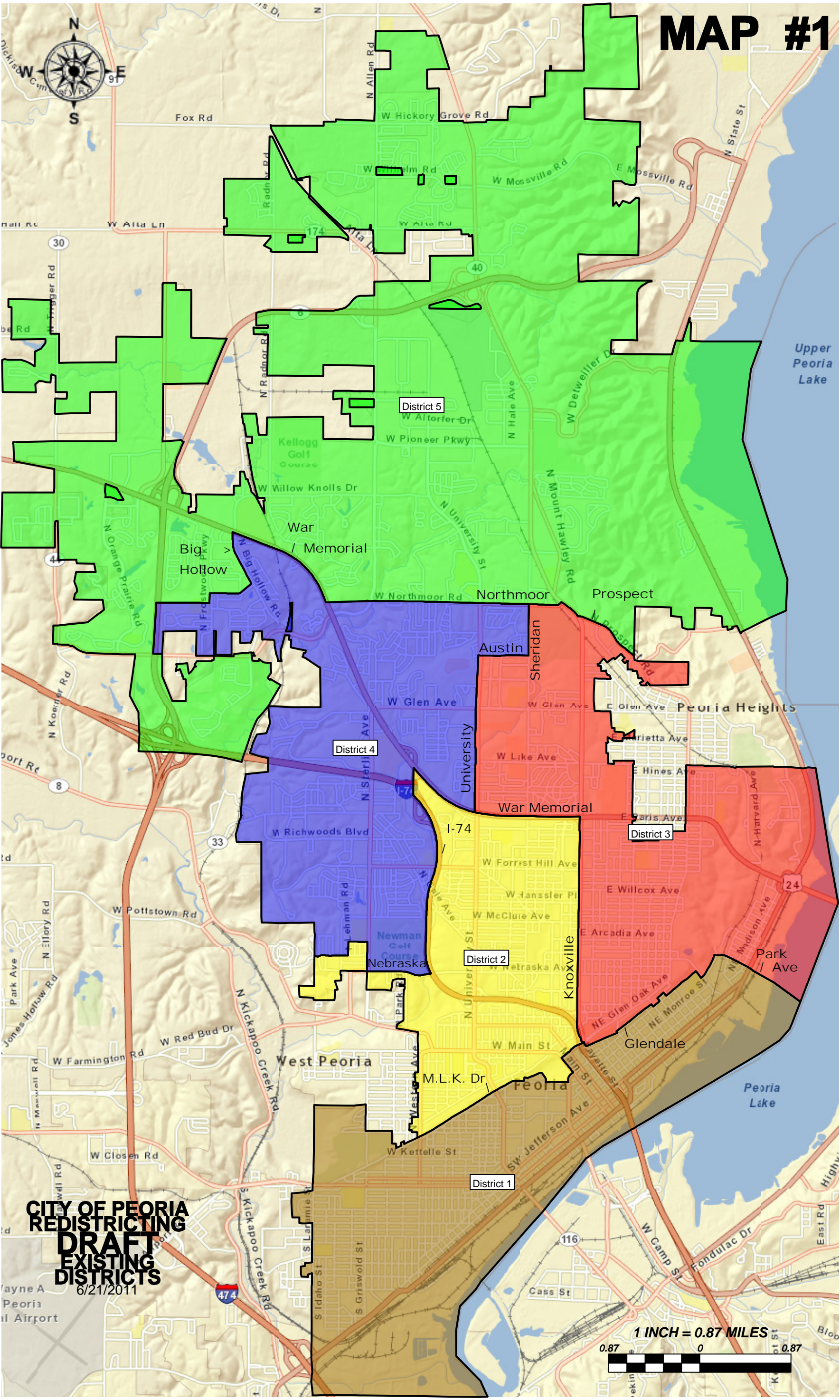
1. Existing Council Districts (Baseline)

9. Existing Boundaries with Expansions Alternative E
10. Existing Boundaries with Expansions Alternative F

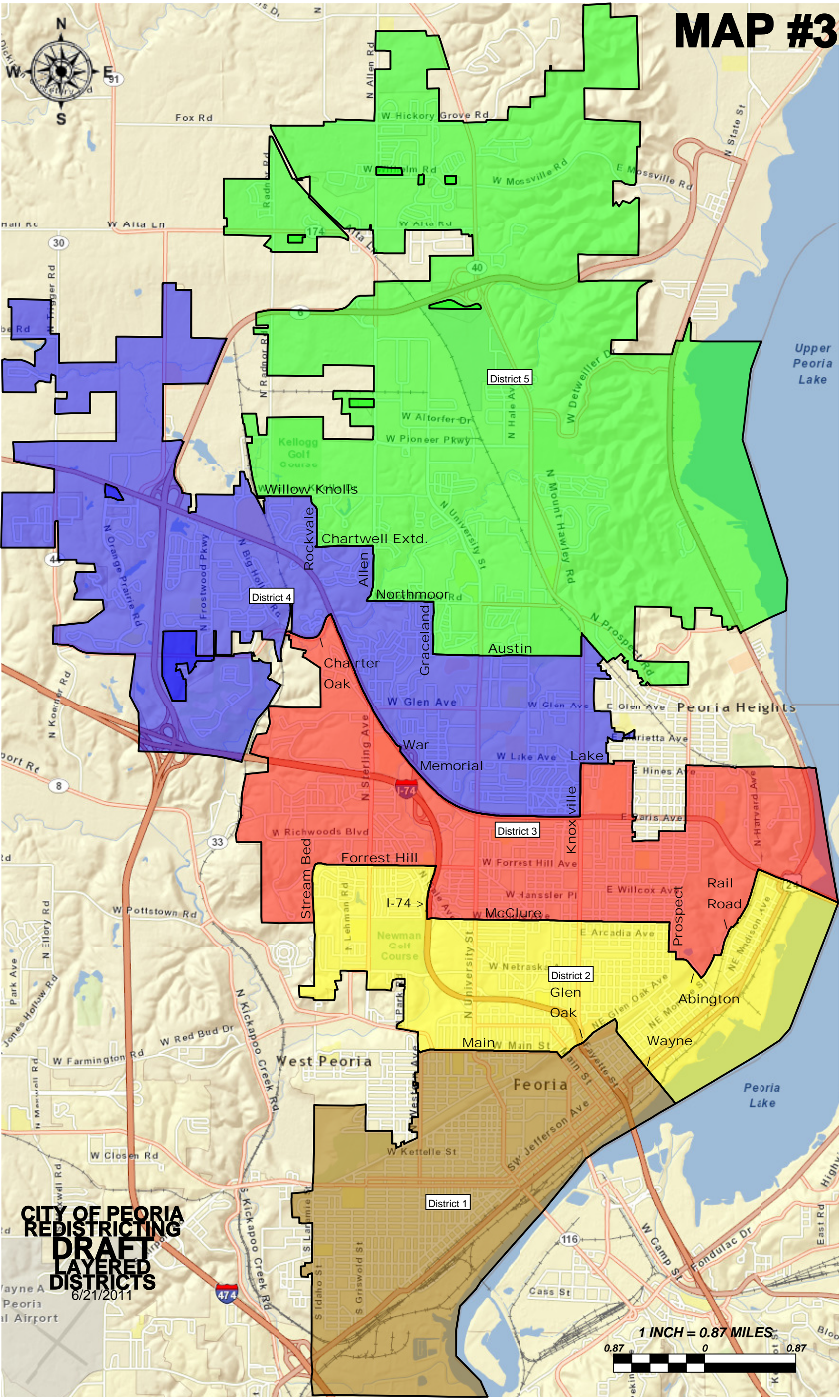

SUBJECT: **CHANGE IN METHOD OF ELECTING COUNCILMEMBERS**

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At the initial meeting of the Redistricting Committee, a question was asked concerning the method of changing the number of districts or making other changes in the way in which the City Council is elected. This memorandum is intended to expand upon and clarify my answer, which remains that any such change would require a referendum. The best course of action would be to pursue an approval of the referendum through the Federal Court that issued the consent decree, which is the basis for our current form of government.

Under Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, a home rule municipality is authorized, subject to referendum approval, to adopt procedures for selecting municipal officers. The Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1 *et seq.*, provides various forms of government. However, a home rule municipality is not limited to these specific forms and numbers of Councilmembers provided for in the Illinois Municipal Code, Opinion of the Illinois Attorney General No. 05-007. Our current form provides for half of the Council to be elected by districts and half to be elected at-large, with staggered terms. This closely follows 65 ILCS 5/5-2-18.7, but differs in that the number of Councilmembers is ten (10) and that the at-large Councilmembers are elected through cumulative voting. It is important to recognize that for any change in the form of government, the referendum must provide adequate specifics as to how a new government would work and how the representatives would be elected. The exact wording of the referendum will be very important but, at this stage, it is sufficient to say that this Committee, if it chooses to pursue a change in the manner of electing Councilmembers, has numerous options available to it, including but not limited to eliminating cumulative voting for at-large elections. After an alternative is agreed upon, the process of drafting exact language for a referendum can begin.

Public question referenda are limited to primary and general elections. The next primary election is March 20, 2012. Council-initiated questions must be submitted seventy-nine (79) days before an election or by January 3, 2012. The General Election is November 6, 2012, with a deadline of August 20, 2012, for adopting of public questions. Changing the form of government in the November election would not result in a timely redistricting for the scheduled 2013 Municipal Election. Therefore, if such a change is sought, it is highly recommended that a decision be reached in 2011.



This Committee may seek maps showing different numbers of Districts. The next step would be for this Committee to refer and/or recommend changes to the entire Council.
